

## Fall 2025 - Spring 2026 Semester Payment Options

Full-time undergraduate and graduate international students may choose one of the following three options for satisfying their financial obligation to the University.

**Option One:** Pay the full fall amount due by August 15 and the full spring amount due by December 15.

**Option Two:** Pay the full semester amount due in two equal payments. The first fall semester payment is due on August 15 and second payment is due on or before September 15. The first spring semester payment is due on December 15 and the second payment is due on or before January 15. *The second payment is assessed an additional 1.5% finance charge.*

**Option Three:** Pay the full semester amount due in three equal payments. The first fall semester payment is due on or before August 15, the second payment is due by September 15, and the third payment is due by October 15. The first spring semester payment is due on December 15, the second payment is due by January 15, and the third payment is due by February 15. *The second and third payments are assessed an additional 1.5% finance charge.*

## Methods of Payment

Students may make payment by:

- Cashier's check (drafted on a U.S. bank)
- Electronic check transfer (drafted on a U.S. bank)
- Traveler's check
- Bank wire
- Credit card (subject to 2.5% service fee)

**Cash is not accepted.** Students are cautioned not to carry large sums of cash.

**IMPORTANT WIRE TRANSFER INFORMATION:** Bank wire information is printed on the estimated invoice provided in your packet. For additional wire information contact the Office of Student Financial Services at [offstudacct@evansville.edu](mailto:offstudacct@evansville.edu) or call (812-488-2565). Be sure to indicate student's name and the student's University of Evansville identification number on all wire transfers. **A wire fee of \$16 should be included with each wire sent.** CAUTION! The University of Evansville will never request a wire be sent to an individual. All wires should be sent directly to the University of Evansville with the student listed as beneficiary.

**IMPORTANT CREDIT CARD PAYMENT INFORMATION:** The University of Evansville accepts Mastercard, VISA, American Express, and Discover credit cards for payments of semester charges. Payments made by credit card will be subject to a 2.5% service fee. **Please check with the issuing bank to make sure that the credit card can be used in the United States and to determine daily transaction limits.**

## Student Account Status

Any student unable to satisfy the University of Evansville payment requirements will be subject to dismissal from the University, which may result in loss of visa status by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).
