



# 'With Family' Housing Status Parent/Guardian Residency Verification Students Entering Prior to Fall 2023

The University of Evansville provides students who are residents of Vanderburgh, Posey, Gibson, Warrick, and Henderson counties the opportunity to commute if they will be living with parents or legal guardians during the academic year.

Students who live beyond these counties but who wish to commute/live at home with parents or legal guardians must complete this form as documentation of the residency.

Students who are legal residents of these counties but residing at locations other than the home of their parents or legal guardians are not considered commuters living at home. The student's financial aid award will be adjusted according to the policies of the Office of Student Financial Services.

I understand that should I alter this decision at any time during this period, I am required to notify the Office of Student Financial Services. I further understand that providing false information for the purpose of attaining commuter status may result in financial aid penalty and disciplinary action according to the student handbook."**
