Whether it's following a transfer plan you started at your community college, completing the degree that keeps getting put off, embarking on a second degree to launch a new career, or even beginning as a first-time student at a nontraditional age, the University of Evansville can help you make your educational goals a reality.

Let's get started!

Visiting is an important part of your college search. We encourage you to schedule a visit to tour campus as well as meet with an admission counselor, faculty in your area of interest, and a career coach. Visit soon enough and UE will add an additional \$1,000 per year to your scholarship award!

Apply for admission (it's free). You'll also be considered for all UE scholarships through the application for admission. We recommend that you apply by August 1 for the fall semester or December 1 for the spring semester to allow for consideration of scholarships and financial aid. Transfer students with a cumulative GPA (CGPA) of 2.5 or above will likely be admitted. Transfer Nursing applicants must have a minimum CGPA of 2.75.

Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended to the UE Office of Admission. For ease, consider requesting your transcripts through a transcript service like Parchment (parchment.com) or National Student Clearinghouse (studentclearinghouse.org). Nursing applicants also need to submit an SAT (1100), ACT (22), or ATI TEAS score (proficient) taken within the last five years.

Transferring Your Credits

UE generously awards transfer credits. Courses taken at regionally accredited institutions with a grade of "C-" or above typically transfer except for Nursing prerequisite courses, which require a minimum grade of "C". UE will accept up to 60 credit hours from community colleges and up to 72 hours from four-year institutions. On average, students need to complete a minimum of 48 credit hours to earn a

bachelor's degree from UE. Transfer credit estimates are available upon request from the Office of Admission, and articulation agreements (transfer pathways) and a credit equivalency guide are available on the website. If you need advice about what to take at your college to ensure courses will transfer to UE, we can help!
